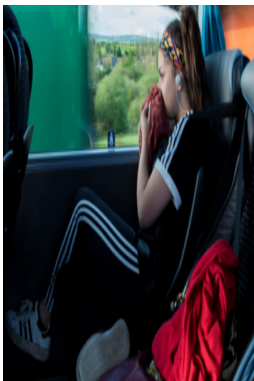


Amélie Amayen
